Job Description

Project: The current impact assessment uses qualitative data to assess the impact of ChopArt on its participants. Impact assessment is moving towards using pre/post test data, input of parents and community stake holders.

Description of Work: Work involves using quantitative and qualitative analysis to assess the impact of the Chop Art program. Job responsibilities would include searching the literature, identifying valid and reliable measurements, developing / implementing assessments, screening results, and analyzing/ presenting data on the impact of Chop Art on its participants. Includes research and development of final report.

Experience in research analysis is required. Meticulousness and strong work ethic are essential. Minimum requirement of a bachelor's degree, preferably in psychology. Demonstrated possession of the competencies necessary to perform the work
